English Language:

1. Write a *critical review* of a movie that you watch during your Summer Vacation.

English Literature:

1. Write a note on the roles played by the three witches to decide the destiny of the play with reference to '*Macbeth*'.

History:

1. Choose anyone topic from the following and write an essay of around 2000 words in length.
 - a) Which power is more responsible for launching the cold war, USA or USSR?
 - b) Trace the historical background to the Palestinian conflict and suggest a solution for ending the conflict.

Geography:

Make a project on any island area of the world or India and:

1. Trace the map of the area and show physical feature, towns and port cities.
2. Prepare a project report using photographs and pictures to show:
 - Its origin and formation.
 - Soil types, vegetation.
 - Human occupations.

Political Science:

1. Make a project on the "Relevance" of the United Nations in a Unipolar World".

Or

Make a project on the "Relevance of SAARC as a Forum of regional co- operations".

2. Prepare at least 20 Questions / Answers from the chapter "Fundamental Concepts".

Psychology:

1. Define Psychology as a social science and also explain the specific features of schools of psychology. Describe the relative importance of heredity and environment.

Physical Education:

1. Complete your practical file & make a project on any one game & sport of your interest based on the ISC prescribed syllabus.

Environmental Science:

You are recommended to complete one project from the list given below. The project work could take one of the five forms:

- 1: Address a current environmental problem (preferably at local or regional scale) and should include problem identification and analysis, use of secondary data as well as some collection of primary data, design of solution, documentation of the entire process in the form of a solution proposal.
- 2: Conduct a study on the density and population of the plants growing in a particular area using the quadrat method.
- 3: Field work and training in an environmental organization (NGOs, Industrial Pollution Control Firms, Testing Laboratories etc.) for a period of not less than one month. This work should be focused on one area in the syllabus.
- 4: Systematic monitoring of an aspect of the local environment over a period of at least six months.
- 5: Design and conduct an environment impact assessment. The candidates may use secondary data, demonstrate their capacity to collect and analyse primary data by incorporating some primary data collected and use it in a few sectors of their work.
